The Washington Center suggests that students budget \$150.00 per week for living expenses. Note that actual expenses will range relative to the student's ability to manage money and their approach to experiencing the nation's capital. **For more information go to www.twc.edu/florida.**

***Florida & TWC Scholarships:** Undergraduate USF students will receive a \$8,000 scholarship for the fall, spring, and summer semesters. **To receive the funding, students must register for at least 6 credits at USF for the experience. Another \$1,000 of the scholarship requires living in TWC housing. The Florida Scholarship and TWC Scholarships do not come to you directly, they are deducted from the amount each student owes TWC.**

It is also recommended that students submit their applications to TWC two weeks before the priority deadlines.

****USF Tuition:** You must register for 6 USF credits in order to participate in TWC. To receive the full Florida Scholarship you must register for at least 6 credits, combined in POS 4941 (TWC) and POS 4910 (TWC) but you can register for a maximum of 12 credits for the fall and spring semesters and 9 for summer. You will pay for the USF tuition as you normally do, including scholarships and loans. **You pay tuition directly to USF.**
